Genealogy Extract Tool

Instruction Sheet

Use this tool to identify relationships for family members from historical documents.

1. Abstract names from an historical document into the form. This standardizes information and quickly helps you identify relationships
2. Abstract names for witnesses and others who do not directly link into the family group into the Comments area for later analysis (these people hold clues to your family)
3. Enter data from one resource into one form. It is important to isolate your facts until you have enough information to tie the families together accurately.
4. Analysis is much easier when all the data is placed into a standardized format.
5. Data from the Genealogy Extract Tool can be added to the timeline for a specific person, this offers further analysis opportunities.
